NHRC advisory for protection of those involved in begging NHRC, India issued an Advisory to the Centre and State governments and UT Administrations to develop strategies aimed at eliminating the need for begging and enhancing the quality of life for those involved. It has been noted that despite initiatives and welfare programmes by both the Centre and State Governments, the issue of begging persists across the country. As per the 2011 census, there were more than 413 thousand beggars and vagrants in India including women, children, transgender and the elderly.

NHRC takes notice of children deaths at Ashram in Indore

NHRC, India took suo moto cognisance of the media reports that 30 children fell ill and five died at an Ashram (Shelter Home) in Indore district, Madhya Pradesh. They are of 5 to 15 years of age. Reportedly, blood infection and food poisoning are suspected to be the reasons behind this. Most of the children living in the ashrams are orphans.

The Commission has observed the contents of the media report, if true, raise a serious issue of violation of the human rights of the children.
